"CDFI ERP is designed to:

- 1) provide funding to CDFIs to expand lending, grant making and investment activities in low- or moderate-income communities and to borrowers that have significant unmet capital and financial services needs and have experienced disproportionate economic impacts from the COVID-19 pandemic, and
- 2) enable CDFIs to **build organizational capacity and acquire technology, staff,** and other tools necessary to accomplish the activities under a CDFI ERP Award."
