The International Rescue Committee (IRC) Small Business Development Center (SBDC) provides no-cost in-language business assistance to small businesses and entrepreneurs through technical assistance, training, and access to business grants and microloans to start or expand their business, with a focus on helping refugees, immigrants and individuals from underserved communities.

#### IRC SBDC PROGRAMS

- Business Counseling services for start up and small businesses
- Available in 19 languages through multi-lingual staff and interpreters
- Business Boot Camps and training in Arabic, English and Spanish
- San Diego STEPS and ORR- Child Care training, certification and grants program that enables women and men to start in home child care businesses serving their communities in Arabic, Dari, Farsi, Pashto, English and Spanish
- SBA CNPP Navigation of financial relief for minority and underserved communities in San Diego 921 zip code neighborhoods
- Help clients become lender ready by building credit, helping them prepare business plans, P and L's and financial projections and navigating loan and grant application process

- IRC SBDC works very closely with IRC CEO to help our clients access financing to build their credit and start or grow their business
- Credit building loans of \$100, \$300 and \$1,000 at zero interest
- Business loans up to \$2500 at zero interest
- \$10K business loan product that was ideal for Islamic communities up to \$10K for 18-72 months is no longer offered
- Opportunities to start and build a business with zero interest loan products are critical to strengthen and grow our client's small businesses



Business loans up to \$50,000 at fixed rates 2.9% to 7.75%

- In 2022-2023 IRC SBDC has worked with entrepreneurs from Iraq, Somalia, Afghanistan, Sudan and Syria who are rebuilding their lives in the US
