Passed in 1977, the Community Reinvestment Act was Congress's response to historical redlining practices that denied bank loans to people and communities of color. CRA encourages banks to lend to communities that have been historically marginalized. Small business loans, first-time homebuyer loans, and funding for affordable housing developments are all made possible by CRA.

Come learn about CRA and efforts to update and protect it. We will be joined by speakers from from three of the nation's strongest advocacy organizations promoting economic equity: the Greenlining Institute, the California Reinvestment Coalition, and the National Community Reinvestment Coalition. They will share the story behind CRA and tools and methods for making your voice heard in Washington, DC. as policy makers re-examine this critical law.

The Federal Reserve is considering changes to CRA and asking for public input by February 16. You can tell the Federal Reserve how important it is to strengthen CRA and make it an even more powerful tool for shepherding capital into under-resourced communities.
